Papers must be original work, not previously published, written in English. Abstracts are not accepted.

The conference uses double-blind review by at least two specialized reviewers. Before final acceptance, all the reviewers' comments must be considered.

We require that at least one author of an accepted paper to register the paper by the deadline above to join the Workshop and to present the paper. This registration deadline is strictly required to all authors of accepted papers.

Only the registered and presented papers will be published in the conference proceedings and will be submitted to IEEE Xplore digital library for POTENTIAL inclusion as well as other Abstracting and Indexing (A&I) databases such as Scopus.
