The **IFIP Working Group 11.8 - Information Security Education** will hold the Tenth World Conference on Information Security Education (WISE10) in order to advance the state of computer security and information assurance education throughout the world. To that end, we invite practitioners, researchers, and policy makers from academia, industry, and government to submit papers for presentation and working group topics to WISE10. We will organize the conference around paper presentations and potential working group topics. All presentations and discussions will be in English.

WISE10 will be held in conjunction with the 2017 IFIP International Information Security Conference (SEC2017). The conference will feature general paper sessions and a working group session.

- Paper submissions should follow the guidelines for full paper submission using the template that can be found at <a href="http://www.ifiptc11.org/wg118-events/wise10#authors-guideline">http://www.ifiptc11.org/wg118-events/wise10#authors-guideline</a> and are to be submitted through EasyChair at <a href="https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=wise10">https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=wise10</a>. The submissions for WISE will be reviewed separately from the SEC2017. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Papers must be original work, not previously published, written in English, and up to 10 pages long. All submissions will be reviewed double blind and must be submitted in a full and blinded version (author and institution information removed). Submission instructions are available on the conference website. Acceptance will be based upon originality, contribution to the field, and relevance to the conference. The conference proceedings will be published under the IFIP Advances in Information and Communication Technology Series by Springer (with ISBN and indexed in Scopus) and distributed at the conference.
- **Submissions for working group topics** should describe in ~500 words the topic of the working group, its relevance to IFIP TC11, WG11.8, the goals to be achieved during WISE, and plans for continued collaboration after WISE.
